

# Retired member as per SASOHN Constitution

## 4.1 Retired Members

- (a) These are Members who have reached retirement age by 1 September of the specific calendar year, who do take on employment from time to time (locum and other) in the field of Occupational Health and want to retain SASOHN membership through payment of membership fees. The following criteria shall apply:
- I. **Age 60-64** – a reduction of 25% of current SASOHN annual membership fees including the option to receive Occupational Health SA Journal,
  - II. **Age 65 and older** – a reduction of 50% of current SASOHN annual membership fees and includes the option to receive Occupational Health SA Journal.
- (b) These members shall receive all communication from their region of membership.
- (c) If actively involved and a full member of SASOHN, may have voting rights at the regional AGM and hold a regional committee position.
- (d) Retired members working outside the field of occupational health (Locum or other) will not be entitled to the above stated.
- (e) Shall inform the regional Committee and SASOHN National office in writing on final decision of permanent retirement and cessation of SASOHN membership.
